To change homepage images you must be an admin on your community's website. There are two ways to change images on the homepage.

The first way is only available if your website has been updated within the past several years.



You should now be viewing the public homepage, however an extra button should be at the bottom of the content called "edit feature description." Select this button.

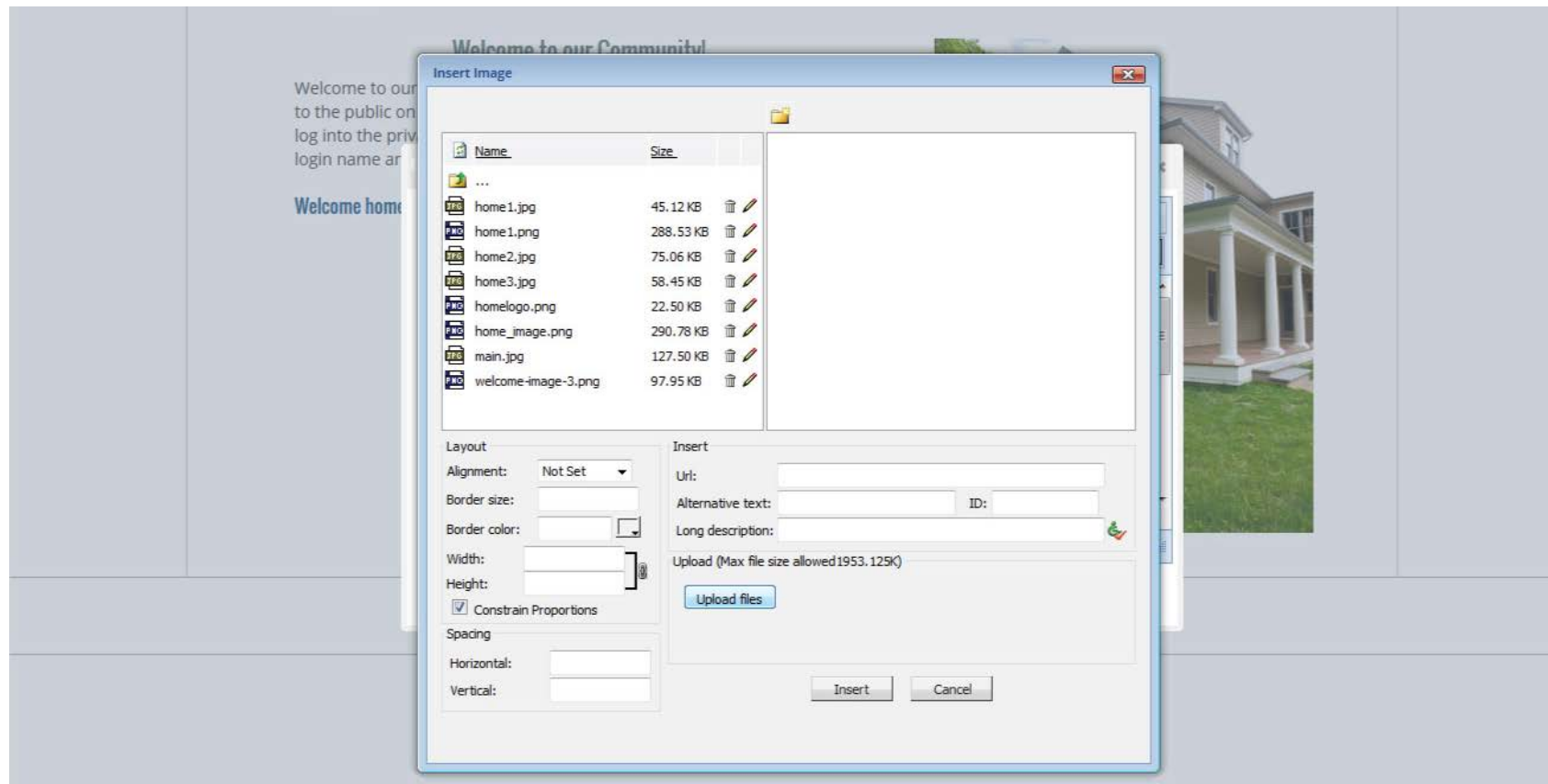



Make sure than any images uploaded have no spaces in the title and are under 1900k file size or they will not be accepted by our system.




On this page you can also align the image to a side, change the width/height of the image and add spacing around the image.

Once added images can be moved around by dropping and dragging within the editor, however if an alignment is set the image will keep that alignment unless it is changed or turned off by double-clicking the image within the editor.




